

## *Miss Warner Robins Outstanding Teen 2011 Wardrobe Guidelines*

Provided below are guidelines for the wardrobe you will need to participate in the 2011 Miss Warner Robins Outstanding Teen Scholarship Pageant.

### **Interview**

Contestants **will not** be allowed to wear suits. Instead of suits, the contestants should wear teen stylish clothing. The outfit should be reflective of her personality and age. She should look fresh, hip and young. More important, she should look like a teen.

### **Opening Number**

Black pants, black shoes (make sure you can do some dancing in them) and a top of your choice that SPARKLES. It can be any color or style.

### **On-stage Question**

You will be judged in your on-stage question wearing your interview outfit or Evening Wear-we will let you know when we find out how many contestants are in the pageant.

### **Talent**

Wear something appropriate for your talent. The rules of good taste and **age appropriateness** should prevail. Remember that stage lights are strong and you need to make sure you have sufficient lining with any talent outfit. Props are discouraged unless absolutely necessary.

### **Fitness Wear**

Contestants will wear an outfit of their choice but perform the same modeling routine that will be taught during rehearsals. This is a modeling routine and will be fun and fast-paced. Outfits can be any color of athletic wear such as boy shorts, capri's or skorts. Tops are t-shirts, halter tops or sports tops. Contestants can be creative without embellishments – no sequins, stone, beads, etc. In other words - no sparkle. This is not an extension of your talent competition.

### **Evening Wear**

Contestants are allowed to wear any type of Evening Wear – pants, cocktail dresses, or the traditional gown. Shoes and jewelry should coordinate with the ensemble. Again, good taste and age appropriateness should dictate your choice.
